THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY CHAIRPERSON DIANA KNAPP. ASSESSOR JANA CAVANAUGH, ASSESSOR SUZANNE SZYNDLAR, AND ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT MARGARET GONNEVILLE WERE ALSO PRESENT.

THE BOARD REVIEWED THE MEETING NOTICE FOR THE PLANNING BOARD MEETING SCHEDULED ON JANUARY 10, 2023.

THE BOARD REVIEWED AND DISCUSSED THE ASSESSORS' BUDGET FOR FY2024. ON A MOTION DULY MADE BY CAVANAUGH AND SECONDED BY SZYNDLAR, IT WAS UNANIMOUSLY VOTED TO APPROVE THE FY2024 ASSESSORS' BUDGET AS SUBMITTED.

ASSESSOR CAVANAUGH STATED SHE WOULD HELP TO REWRITE THE PROCEDURE AND HAD A SAMPLE OF A PROCEDURE AVAILABLE FROM THE TOWN OF WENHAM WITH A CHECKLIST ADDED.
