I. POLICY

- 1. Residential open burning season is from January 15th to May 1st. These dates are state regulated and there are no exceptions. Agricultural burning is yearround.
- 2. The daily hours for Residential burning are 10am to 4pm. The daily hours for Agricultural burning are 8am-4pm. All fires must be out by 4.
- 3. Residential open burning permits are issued and renewed by the fire department.
- 4. Agricultural burning permits are primarily issued by the fire department
- 5. Burning permits must be renewed every year on the date of issue.
- 6. Burning permits are called in to 508-763-2611 option #2.

II. COOK FIRE

- 1. Those wishing to have a cook fire do not have to call and advise us, however we appreciate the call and ask them to do so as a courtesy.
- 2. A cook fire is allowed any time of day, it is the request of the Fire Department that they be out by midnight.
- 3. If there is a burning ban in effect, that also includes cook fires.

III. AGRICULTURAL BURNING PERMITS

- 1. The initial issue of an Agricultural Burning Permit is issued by the Fire Department.
- 2. Agricultural burning will only be issued to those that have land that is classified as 60, 61, 61a, and 61b.
- 3. Agricultural burning is year-round from 8am-4pm.
- 4. During normal burning season they are advised to call in on the recording. During non-burning season they must call in to the fire department to advise they are going to burn, at 508-763-1709.
