Minutes:

Fire Chief Scott Weigel – American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funding request for new radios – Fire Chief Weigel is present to discuss funding for new radios for the fire department and the police department. Town Administrator Cannon informs everyone that recently Select Board Member Murphy and himself had a meeting at our dispatch center where a representative from the Town of Hanover mentioned the potential of donating radios to Rochester once they transition over to new ones. The Board decides to table this discussion until more information is available.
