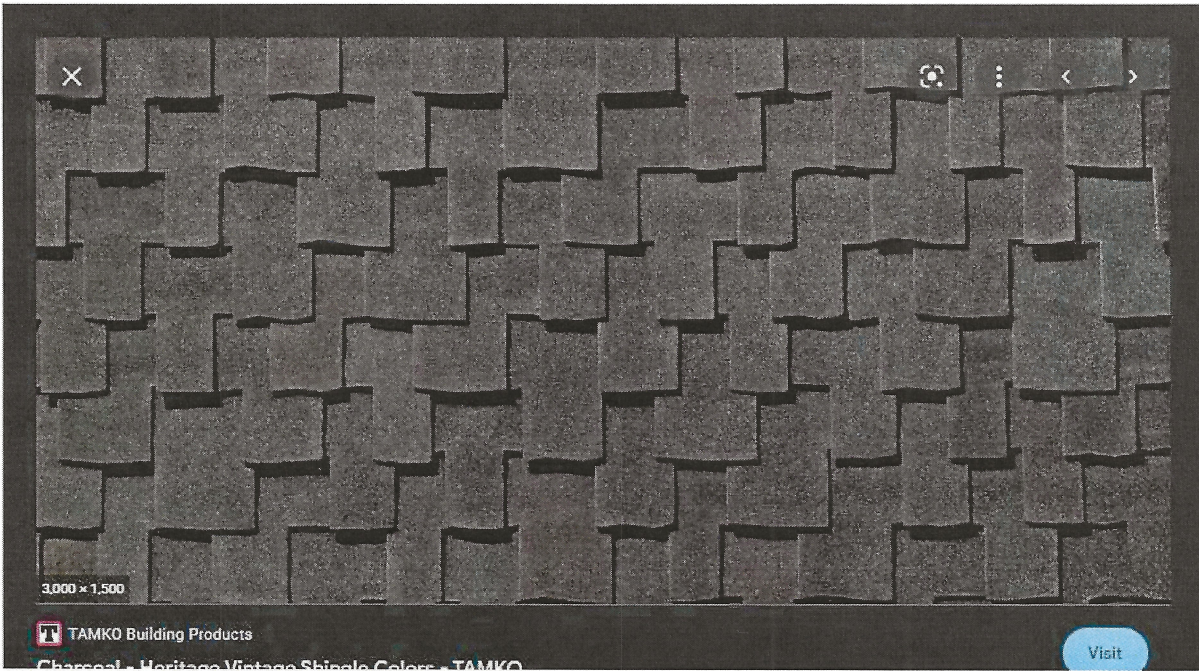

Strip off one layer asphalt shingle and second layer of cedar shingles off roof. Install 1/2 cdx plywood over roof boards. Put down 6ft of ice and water shield paper whole roof with 30lb synthetic paper. Install 8 inch white aluminum drip edge on bottom and sides of roof change out all pipe boot flanges. Re shingles with 50 year gaf timberline HDZ roof shingles hurricane nailed. Install new lead flashing around all chimneys. Install new ridge vent cap roof. Price includes labor materials warranty dumpster and permit. 33,450.00

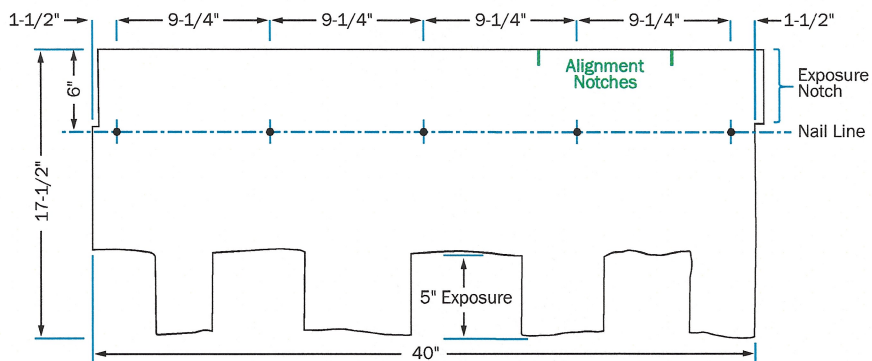

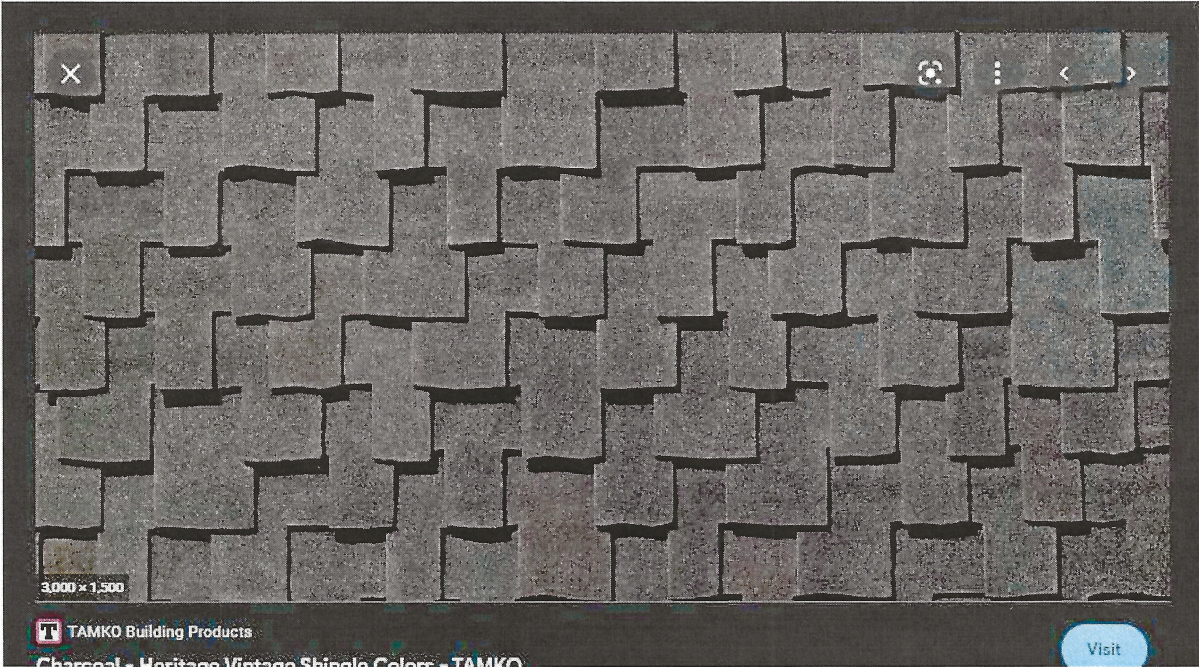
